

Jam and Jelly Taste Test Contest Rules

1. Products may be made in pint, quart, or any other acceptable container for the process.
2. Containers will be opened and tested. The contents will NOT be saved at the end of the contest.
3. Labeling: if you wish to pick up your container after the contest, please discreetly label the bottom (like an address label.) At the time of entry, an address label will be placed on the product by the superintendent marking the contents and lot #.
4. Entry: Product may be entered during open class entry times - Monday from 4-8 and Tuesday from 10-5. Product may also be entered on Wednesday August 18th from 6-7, prior to the event.
5. Renville County Fair WILL NOT accept any refrigerated product during open class entry (Monday or Tuesday) they must be brought in on Wednesday.
6. You need not be present to participate in this contest.
7. This is a "people's choice" competition. Judges are selected by the Secretary.
8. Judging is done on a scale from 1-5. 5 being the highest score. Jelly will be sampled on saltine crackers or by taste test spoons at judges' discretion.
9. The contest will be judged by lot. There will be a first and second place winner in each lot. There is a prize of \$5 and \$3 for each lot with the winner of the lot moving to the grand champion contest.
10. No prizes will be awarded if there is only one entry in a lot. That product will still move on to the Championship Round. Prizes will only be awarded if there are three or more entries in a lot.
11. Any of these rules are subject to change at the Secretary's discretion.
12. The Championship Round will result in one winner. The prize is \$25.
