## Open Wine Competition

### Class 35 – Minnesota Grown Grapes or Juice or Global Grapes or Juice

1 Wine Bottle

In addition to being judged by a qualified individual, there will be a “People’s Choice” competition that will take place on Friday, August 19th in the Alliance Pipeline Pavilion from 7-9 PM. All lots will compete in this competition with the overall winner being awarded a prize of \$25.00.

### Rules

1. Wine can be made from a kit.
2. All entries must include a disclosure on the label of the specific variety or varieties of grapes or juice used to make the wine.
3. Wines may be made in any style, (including sparkling) but only materials cleared by the TTB may be used.
4. One entry per person per category will be allowed.
5. Entries are limited to any resident of Minnesota. One member only from any family or household may submit an entry in any lot.
6. Wines entered in a standard clear or colored glass bottles are preferred but wine bottled in any other glass beverage bottle 25-34 oz is acceptable. The wine will be judged Friday afternoon, after which it will be moved to the beer garden for the “people’s choice” competition.
7. A 3” X 5” label needs to be attached to the bottle indicating winemakers name, address, type of wine and vintage year. The label will be covered by the superintendent during judging.
8. Entries must be brought to the Flowers, Produce and Foods building prior to 6:00 pm on Friday August 19th.
9. If you wish to pick up your container after the contest, please discreetly label the bottom (like an address label.)
10. Any of these rules are subject to change at the Secretary’s discretion
