

80'S AND NEWER CHAIN CLASS (1/4" chain only) DEMOLITION DERBY RULES

1. Must be of a metric body and newer than 1977, as this was the first year for mass produced metric cars.
2. No cutting, welding, bolting or bending of frame or body allowed except wheel wells and bumpers may be cut or bent to clear tires. NO REINFORCEMENTS!
3. Bumpers and bumper bracket must be stock for vehicles year make and model.
4. Drivers door may be welded shut for safety. All other doors are allowed 2 chains per door seam, A door bar is allowed, drivers side only. It must not exceed past door seams, and must be visible.
5. Shift linkage must remain stock, no modifications.
6. Trunk and hood must be chained shut, 6 spots max for each.
7. Transmission cooler must remain stock or be disconnected.
8. No welded or posi type rear ends.
9. Dash must be left in, if not you will not run.
10. Any DOT tires are ok. Doubles are ok.
11. A seat bar is mandatory for drivers safety, but cannot be more than 1" behind seat. Drivers door may have welded strips, mesh or a safety net.
12. Windshield may have vertical bar, but cannot be more than 1" in diameter.
13. Only one battery allowed.
14. Coil springs may be chained or cabled, but only to keep them from falling out.
15. Engines and transmissions must be stock and in stock location.
16. Stock manifolds only, no headers.
17. This is a stock division.
